**Rules:**

- All contestants must be full time residents of Williamson County.
- Each contestant must reach her 16<sup>th</sup> birthday, but not her 21<sup>st</sup> birthday, on or before December 31, 2010. The Fair reserves the right to require proof of age upon request.
- All contestants must never have been married nor had a child.
- \$25 check must accompany application. Make check or money order payable to Williamson County Fair.
- Dresses must be a formal, floor length pageant dress. Interview suit or dress will be required for interview, and will be worn on stage during the beginning of the pageant.
- The Winner must be able to represent the Fair at different events during the week of the fair, and throughout the year. If the contestant cannot attend the State Fairest of the Fair Contest in January, 2011, she must relinquish her crown and the 1<sup>st</sup> Runner-up will become the new Fairest of the Fair.
- The contestant and one chaperone will be admitted at no charge to the Fair on the day of the pageant.
- Only one chaperone will be allowed in dressing room with contestant.
- The Winner will receive a Trophy, Crown, and Banner, plus \$200 for expenses at the State Pageant. The Williamson County Fair will pay for room and board at the State Pageant. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> runners-up will also receive beautiful rhinestone crowns. All contestants will receive a beautiful crown and rose.
- Sportsmanship and manners are required of all contestants.
- Contestants will be judged on Interview, Beauty, Poise, and Personality – 1/4 each.
- Dressing room will be in the trailer behind the stage. You can put your pageant clothes, etc. in trailer when you arrive after interviews at the Bunganut Pig Restaurant.
